Who sits in back of yet another classroom, surrounded by strangers.

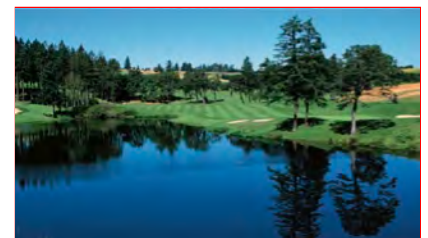
I am for the child who one day will turn 18— and will be surrendered to the world.

Imagine being a child who is abused or neglected by those who should protect you. Imagine being removed from the only home you have ever known and being taken to a foster home. Imagine the fear and pain. Imagine the justice system, where it feels like you have no voice. What if there was someone who could speak just for you? Well, there is: a CASA volunteer.

According to state law, Oregon should be providing every foster child with a CASA as they're ferried through the system, but too many kids go it alone. In the face of the state's budgetary shortfall, however, others are instead looking to make cuts to the CASA program--which is already falling far short of serving every foster child.

The mission of CASA of Clackamas County is to train and support community volunteers to provide a voice in court and advocate for the best interests of abused and neglected children in the foster care system who need safe and permanent homes. The children we serve are victims of the most serious types of maltreatment. CASA volunteers give these vulnerable children a consistent resource who is focused only on their best interests, and a dependable and respected voice as they proceed through the child welfare system.

Our funding comes from people and companies like you. We are concerned citizens doing important work in our home community who need your support. The golf tournament is our signature annual event, and we hope that you will join us. With your help we can continue our work. There are children in need who depend on us.
